

The Devil to Pay – Order Chit Construction & Play Notes



-- Construction notes --

1. Print chits on a white adhesive label (ex: mailing label).
2. Cover with a layer of clear packing tape (to make water resistant)
3. Cut out individually
4. Apply to both sides of an 'Alphabet Tile' (ex: scrabble piece)
 - Google 'Alphabet Tile' to find & purchase inexpensive ones

-- Playing notes --

Set up...

1. Place the chits in small bag (a 'Crown Royal' bag works great)
2. Give the bag a shake

Play...

1. Pull a chit out of the bag and hold it (undisclosed) over the table
2. Ask for 'Skedaddles'
 - If there are no Skedaddles, drop the Chit on the table and play accordingly
 - Blue Chits indicate Union acting first, Grey Chits indicate Confederate acting first
3. Repeat until the second 'Whiskey' chit is drawn (ending the turn)



-- Carpe Diem Note --

Keep the 4 white Chits separate from the bag

- When a 'Carpe Diem' is drawn, hold one of the white Chits (undisclosed over the table)...
- If the winner of the 'Carpe Diem' hesitates giving an order, drop the White Chit. The White Chit immediately becomes their 'Carpe Diem' order
